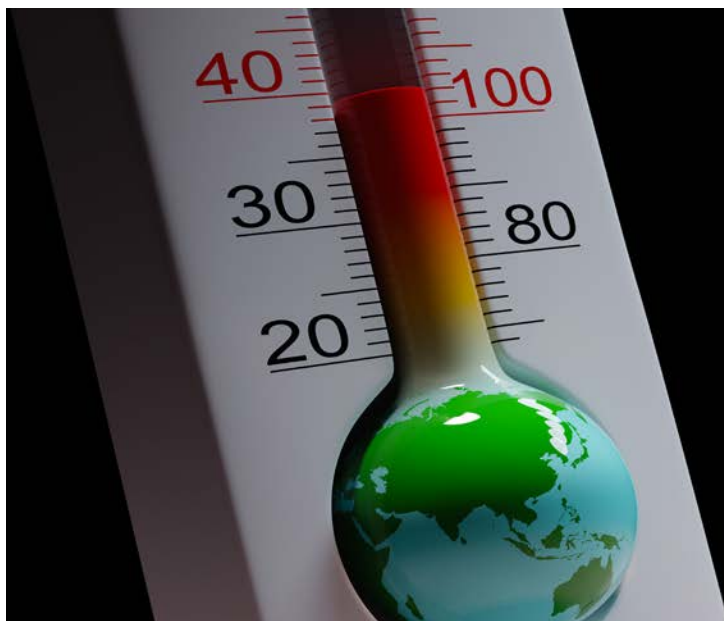

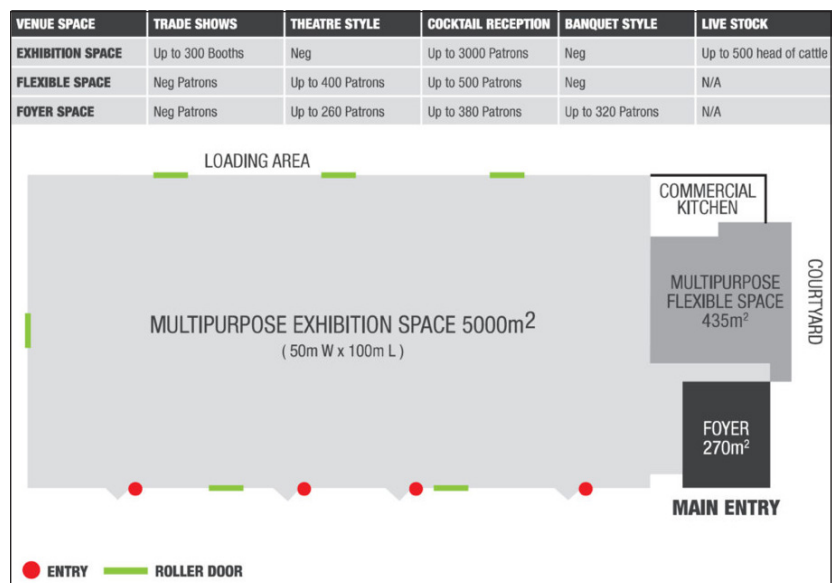


THE VENUE

Located on the Showgrounds site Bendigo's multi-million-dollar Exhibition Centre is one of the largest clear-span facilities of its kind in regional Australia.

The Centre is located less than 3kms from the CBD at the Prince of Wales Showgrounds, Holmes Road, Bendigo.

At five acres in size and with a one-kilometre fence line perimeter it also proudly boasts the largest showgrounds arena to be found in the state including Melbourne.

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Product Demonstrations

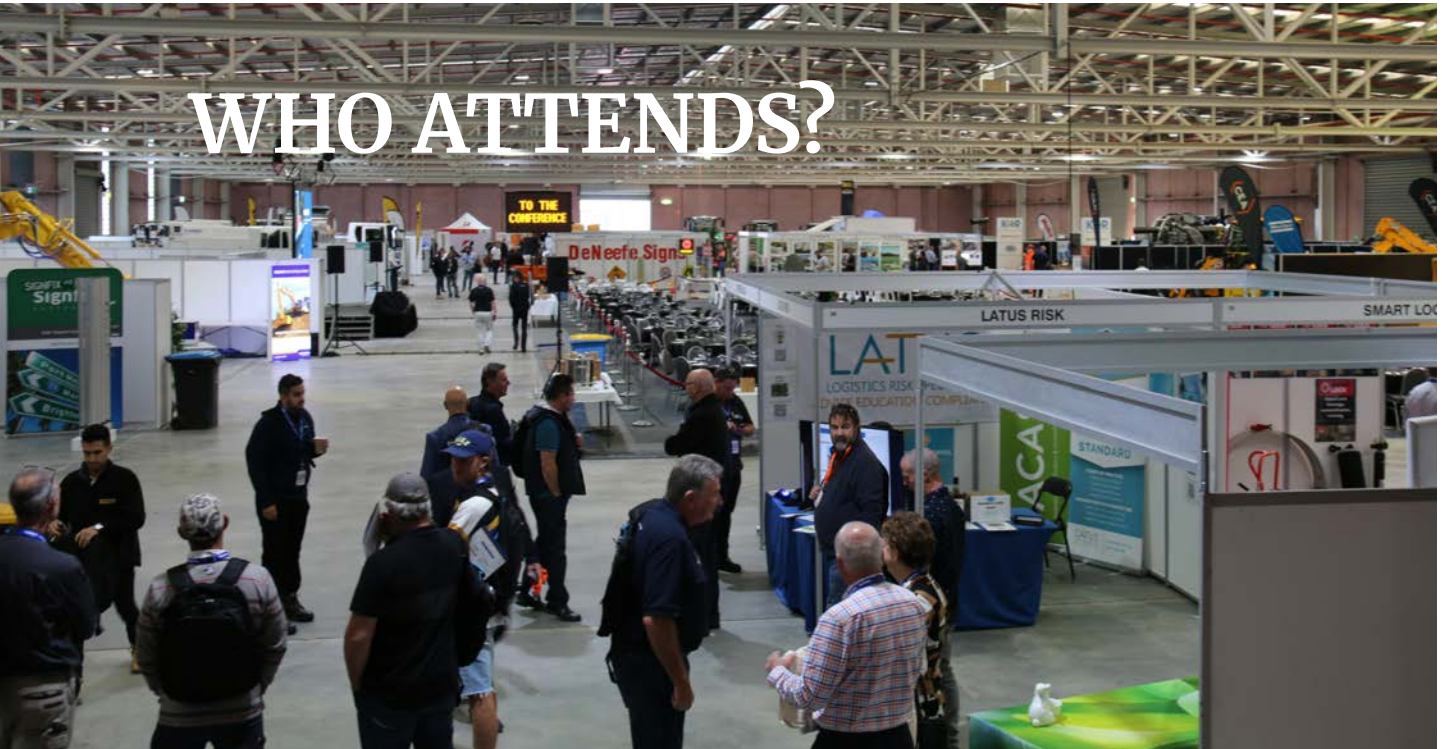
A more recent conference innovation includes the activation of the outdoor demonstration space for use by exhibitors wanting to provide hands on demonstrations of their products and services.
